Q2. You are looking for information about self healing materials for touchscreens. Do you think that, in this case, "coating" and "film" are good synonyms for the aspect "materials"?

Select the best answer from the list.

- A. No. These terms are far too specific to be used in search systems as synonyms for "materials".
- B. No. "Coating" and "film" both mean something completely different.
- C. Yes. They are not literal synonyms, but they are useful additional search terms.
- D. Yes. A self healing coating or film can be applied to touchscreens.
