Q1. "Numerous autopsies have shown that ingested plastic and tar are the primary culprits of stress and non-natural death for sea turtles.

Debris including fishing line, ropes, nets, six pack rings, Styrofoam, and plastic bags have been extracted from turtle digestive tracts." (Sigler, 2014, p. 3)

This text is paraphrased three times: incorrectly, in an acceptable way and in a correct and useful way.

Put the paraphrases in the right order:

- 1. Best
- 2. Acceptable
- 3. Incorrect
- A lot of autopsies have shown that ingested plastic and tar causes stress and non-natural death of sea animals. Debris and plastic bags have been extracted from turtles. (Sigler, 2014, p. 3)
- Autopsies on sea turtles have shown that the plastic pollution causing their deaths includes both household waste and debris from the fishing industry. (Sigler, 2014, p. 3)
- During autopsies of sea turtles, plastic (as fishing line and plastic bags) and tar were found in their stomach and intestines. These substances cause stress and finally a non-natural death. (Sigler, 2014, p. 3)
