## In advance

## How to start?

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1	Go to Brightspace ( <a href="https://brightspace.tudelft.nl">https://brightspace.tudelft.nl</a> ) en log in with your Net-ID (possible from 2 August 2021)
2	Go to "Catalog" (use the tab in the upper part of the screen) and search for International Students Information Literacy 2
3	You will get the following result:
