C) Reference no. 14 refers to a book: (14) Van Der Zwaag, S. (2007). <i>Self Healing Materials: An Alternative Approach to 20 Centuries of Materials Science</i> . Dordrecht: Springer	3) Relevant because it contains highly specific technical information.
D) Reference no. 9 refers to a patent: (9) Kim, H.-M., Chang, Y.-R., & Kim, H. (2012). Korea Patent No. KR20120093088 (A). LG CHEMICAL LTD.	4) Relevant because it presents recent work in a research subject, complete with results.
